Regularly scheduled lessons - weekly or bi-weekly      \$65/hour, \$50/45 minutes

Occasional lessons      \$70/hour  
(Current CU College of Music Students please ask about discount.)

Musicians' Wellness Consultation      \$80/75 minutes

Semesters run Sept. - Dec., Jan. - April, May - Aug. For regularly scheduled lessons, payment for each month is due at the first lesson of that month or a late fee of \$2.50 per lesson will be applied. Payment may be made by cash, check or PayPal. Whenever possible, I will notify students prior to the start of the month of dates that I will be unavailable due to performances, workshops, etc.

Students taking regularly scheduled lessons will receive credit for up to two lessons missed per semester ***due to emergency or to illness with sufficient notice***. Please notify me by phone 303-442-1432 or email. Any lesson credits will be applied to the balance of the next month.

During the summer I will make reasonable exceptions for vacations, employment changes, or study abroad. Major/school holidays will also be flexible.

Should I need to cancel lessons due to illness or emergency, I will notify students by email the day before, or by phone the day of the lesson. When I am away on professional engagements, I will generally notify students in the monthly email update.

***Snow closures*** - if Boulder Valley schools or your school district are closed, I will credit any cancelled lessons. Otherwise, lessons are on as usual.

Students taking bi-weekly lessons may switch weeks with their counterpart when mutually convenient. Check with me to exchange contact information if you wish to have this option.

All lessons take place at my home studio at 7755 Frontage Road, Boulder. Street parking is readily available. Mailing address is 7755 Baseline Rd, Boulder 80303.

Prospective students with allergies please note that there are two cats, a dog and a bird in the home.

Students who wish to record the lesson may bring their own recording device, or a flash card for use with my Zoom video recorder (4GB+ recommended).
